SIMPLE FLASHING AMBER LIGHTS

I used this setup as a support driver in 2002. For 2008, I will be using two such sets. Although the amber lights appear "small", they are quite bright. I use fair size magnets to attach the lights to the roof of the van. Be sure to have adequate length of wiring from the power plug to the first light.

Total cost, excluding wire & connectors = \$15. Also needed: 1 roll of dual speaker wire and connectors; colored tape; and strongish magnets to attach to roof.

Most items are available in generic auto supply stores. This flasher is 12 volt, model "552".

Note the RED TAPE indicates the "hot" wire. THIS MUST BE CONSISTENT throughout the entire circuit. Each amber light has only ONE wire, and must be connected to the "hot" circuit.
